

LEGAL NOTICE. 16

THE KENYA NATIONAL LIBRARY SERVICE BOARD ACT

(Cap. 225)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 11 (*d*) and (*e*) of the Kenya National Library Service Board Act, the Cabinet Secretary for Sports, Culture and the Arts, with the advice of the Kenya National Library Service Board, makes the following Regulations –

THE KENYA NATIONAL LIBRARY SERVICE BOARD
(MEMEBERSHIP, REGISTRATION, SUBSCRIPTION AND FEES)
REGULATIONS, 2015

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Kenya National Library Service Board (Membership, Registration, Subscription and Fees) Regulations 2015.
2. (1) Membership of the library shall be open to institutions and individuals, both Kenyan citizen and non-citizen.
(2) The following shall be required before a non-citizen is registered as a member of the library –
 - (a) Where the non-citizen as an adult –
 - (i) a valid passport;
 - (ii) a letter of introduction from the home office or valid work permit;
 - (iii) one passport size photograph;
 - (b) Where the non-citizen is a child –
 - (i) a valid passport;
 - (ii) one passport size photograph.
3. All primary children of school going age and below shall access the library free of charge.
4. The membership, daily access, annual institutional subscription and book loan fees chargeable to individuals and institutions shall be as set out in part I and II of the Schedule.
5. All library service inquiries shall be as free of charge.
6. (1) The library shall provide a bibliography and reference service to publishers.
(2) The fees chargeable for the services under paragraph (1) shall be as set out in Part III of the schedule.
7. The Kenya National Library Service Board (Membership, Registration, Subscription and Fees) Regulations, 2008 are revoked.
