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REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL FOR THE YEAR 1977

Review of the Year

Again there has been a most unfortunate delay in presenting this Annual Report. As I explained in my Report for the previous year this has been occasioned by problems arising in the processing of data and in obtaining tabulations of vital statistics. Now that new data processing equipment has become available and with the introduction of shift working for the machine operators it is hoped that we shall soon be able to bring these reports up-to-date.

The chief points of interest connected with the multifarious activities of the Department are given in the succeeding paragraphs and at the end of the Report are set out appendices which give statistics covering the more important subjects and provide comparative figures over the last decade.

COMPANIES SECTION

The Section comprises the Registries of Companies, Business Names, Limited Partnerships and Chattels Transfers.

Companies

One thousand seven hundred and six new companies were incorporated during the year 1977. The figure represents a 48.5 per cent increase over 1,149, the figure for 1976.

Of the 1,706 newly incorporated companies 33 were public companies, which in effect indicates a decrease of over 56.6 per cent over last year's figure of 76. Nine public companies were struck off leaving a total of 750 public companies on the register.

The balance of 1,673 of the newly incorporated companies represents private companies. There was an increase of 55.9 per cent in such new registrations. One hundred and fifty-three private companies were struck of the register, leaving a total of 12,651 such companies on the register.

During the year 33 foreign companies were registered, a decrease of 11 over last year's figure. Nine such companies were struck off. The number of foreign companies on the register stood at 930 at the end of the year.

The total amount of nominal capital with which the 1,706 new companies were registered was £19,737,495 compared with £11,891,091, an increase of approximately 66 per cent.

A total of 16 prosecutions were brought against various companies and their officers for failure to comply with the requirements of the Company Act (Cap. 486) such as failing to file annual returns, statutory reports, etc. Charges were withdrawn in four cases, and a further five companies and their officers were discharged by the court. In the remaining nine cases, the officers of these companies were fined a total of Sh. 43,800.

Business Names

Business names on the Register stood at 68,572 as at 31st December, 1977. The number of new business names that was registered in the period was 4,005, an increase of 582 over last year's figure of 3,523 or a 13.6 per cent increase. Seven hundred and eighty names were removed from the Register.

TRADE MARKS AND PATENTS REGISTRIES

There was a decrease in the number of initial trade mark applications and related matters, the percentage decrease over the previous year being 9 per cent; on the other hand, there was an increase in the number of patent registrations during the year, the percentage increase over the previous year being 39 per cent.

Nine applications which were subject to opposition proceedings reached the hearing stage and were formally argued before the Registrar. There was one hearing under rule 32

Patents

There is as yet no machinery for the original registration of patents in Kenya, the law providing only for re-registration of patents previously granted in the United Kingdom. This registration has the effect of extending the patentee's rights to the patent to Kenya. In respect of these patents, 124 patents were registered during the year bringing the total of patents registered in Kenya as at 31st December, 1977 to 2,809. The number of live patents on the register at the same date was 1,398.

Trade Marks

Statistics relating to the general work of the Trade Marks and Patents registry, with comparative figures for the last decade, are shown in Appendix V. Statistics of applications and registration still reveal the same lively interest in the classification of goods which relate to the patent medicine, cosmetic and domestic cleaning preparations, clothing industries and the manufacture of food. The number of live trade marks on the register as at 31st December, 1977 was 15,956.

THE REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES

In all districts except in Marsabit, Mandera, Wajir, Isiolo, Samburu, Turkana and Tana River districts, the department has established its own registries of births and deaths. In the districts where such registries have not been established, registration is carried out by District Commissioners.

Population

The projected population for 1977 was 14,348,000. This represents an increase of approximately 3,405,000 persons or about 31.1 per cent since the last national census of 1969.

Births

The total number of births registered in 1977 was 303,886. Of these 162,986 were males and 140,900 were females. Current births amounted to 276,003 generating an annual crude birth rate of 19.24 per 1,000 population. Late birth registration amounted to 27,883. The overall number of births registered showed an increase of 15,561 over the previous year (i.e. 288,325 to 303,886).

Deaths

The total number of deaths registered in 1977 was 48,209 (27,604 males and 20,605 females), showing a decrease of 2,963 below the previous year. There were 47,319 current deaths registered resulting in an annual crude death rate of 3.30 per 1,000 population. Late deaths registered during the year amounted to 890 compared with 1,248 registered during the previous year. The crude death rate is affected by under-registration of deaths more than births.

Infant Deaths

There were 14,145 infant deaths registered in 1977 generating an average infant mortality rate of 51.25 per 1,000 births registered.

Marriages

The number of marriages registered under the Marriage Act in 1977 was 1,045. This shows a decrease of 407 below the previous year.

Caution

Characteristics peculiar to certain areas such as proximity to municipal and urban hospitals or institutions affect vital statistics of these areas as residents from outside these areas use the facilities without the current indication of their normal residence.

The accuracy of the tables depends primarily on the registration of all births and deaths. There are some problems which may make it impossible to obtain accurate figures, as for example in the remote areas where communication with the general public is difficult. Whilst failure to register births is not very common nowadays, it would appear that a considerable number of deaths are not registered.

Many factors therefore, must be considered for the correct interpretation of vital statistics and it must be clearly stated that anything that affects the denominator or numerator of births and deaths described in the appendices will affect the rates resulting from the computations.

Limiting factors to be kept in mind when interpreting the data are as follows:

- (a) Errors in determination of residence which affect the counting of births and deaths allocated to the district as a whole.
- (b) Under-registration which results in under-counting of events.
- (c) Errors in estimation of population and enumeration which affect any rate requiring a population base for computation.
- (d) The efficiency of the cause of death coding and the clarity and accuracy of the cause of death certification by laymen (Deputy Registrars) which affect the counting of deaths allocated to specific causes of death.

Great care, therefore should be taken when comparing a change in the rate where the frequency of the event is small. A change in one or two events may result in a large percentage in the relative statistics. Any index should be evaluated on the basis of quality, validity, and size of both the numerator and denominator used to derive the rate of ratio.

A further caution is given in connection with reading appendix XVI. Deaths are reported either:

- (a) On Form A2 where a qualified medical practitioner certifies the death and gives a medical cause of death which is coded according to the international statistical classification; or
- (b) on Form A3 where no medical practitioner certifies the death. In the latter case the cause of death is determined by a description of the fatal symptoms (or syndromes).

PUBLIC TRUSTEE SECTION

This section carries out the administration of estates of deceased persons under the Public Trustee Act and the management of trusts accepted under such Act. In the majority of cases the Public Trustee undertakes the administration of those estates where the assets are unadministered either because there is no heir who is prepared or is available to apply for letters of Administration or because the executor or administrator previously appointed has died or cannot be traced. In some cases the Public Trustee is specifically appointed to be an executor by a testator but in such cases the consent of the Public Trustee is required at the time of making the Will. The advantages of appointing the Public Trustee to be an executor, are, first, that there is guaranteed continuity of office by virtue of the Public Trustee's status as a corporation sole, and secondly, the fees charged by the Public Trustee for undertaking and completing the administration of estates are strictly regulated by statute and are not therefore, subject to rapid change.

In addition, the Public Trustee undertakes the administration of trusts. In many cases where a minor is entitled to a legacy or share of the assets of a deceased person and, not infrequently, where an award is made by Court to a person not of full age, the executor or administrator, with the consent of the Public Trustee or the Court, as the case may be, transfers such legacy, share or award to the Public Trustee, who establishes a trust with it. This is administered by the Public Trustee until the whole trust fund is paid over to the former minor upon his or her attaining the age of majority.

The Public Trustee also administers trusts which contain no provision for their maturing after the expiration of a stipulated period and for the trust funds then being paid over to the particular beneficiaries. Common examples of such trusts are those which are set up for purposes such as the furtherance of education, charity, recreation, etc. The duration of such trusts is by their nature frequently extremely lengthy. In such cases the fact that the Public Trustee is a corporation sole is particularly useful as the trust funds vest in the holder of the office and not individual trustees. Consequently, the delay and expense involved in the transfer of funds from individual trustees to their successors in office is obviated.

The Public Trustee is also from time to time appointed manager of the estates of persons of unsound mind under the Mental Treatment Act, and is required to make an annual report of accounts submitted by other managers during the course of each year.

During the year, two thousand two hundred and thirty-one new estates were accepted for administration and one thousand four hundred and twenty-six estates were wound-up and distributed. In the case of trusts, eighty-two new trusts were accepted during 1977 and only nineteen of those already under administration were finished and discharged. The administration causes still actively in hand increased by eight hundred and five causes over the total under administration at the end of the previous year, bringing the total to 4,869 as at 31st December, 1977, whilst in the case of trusts the number under administration at the end of the year was three hundred and nine cases.

BANKRUPTCY, COMPANIES LIQUIDATION AND DEEDS OF ARRANGEMENTS

During the year five receiving orders were made, four at Nairobi, and one at Kisumu. This shows a decrease of seven causes over the previous year. The total amount of deficiency as estimated by debtors was £5,570. Of the five debtors concerned one was Asian and four were Africans. The classification of their respective occupations is shown at appendix XXVII.

The assets realized during the year from debtors' estates and debtors' contributions amounted to £10,920. The sum distributed in dividends to ordinary creditors amounted to £11,310. Twelve discharge applications were made during the year. All were granted subject to suspension for various periods.

Deeds of Arrangement

No Deed of Arrangement was registered during the year.

INSURANCE COMPANIES AND BUILDING SOCIETIES

In the year 1977 three companies ceased to transact business. Three new companies commenced business thus keeping the number of insurance companies constant at 45 as in the previous year.

Statistics showing countries of origin of insurers and classes of insurance business which they conduct may be found in Appendix XXXII and Appendix XXXIII gives a breakdown of the main features of insurance business during 1973 to 1977.

BUILDING SOCIETIES

The United Kenya Building Society registered in 1972 has not yet commenced business. Kiambere Building Society registered in 1976 has not commenced business. Business transacted by the East African Building Society can be seen in Appendix XXXIV.

HIRE-PURCHASE SECTION

At 31st December, 1977 fifty businesses were licensed to conduct Hire-Purchase Business. This is an increase of six businesses over the previous year.

By 31st December, 1977 35,395 Hire-Purchase Agreements had been registered.

A sum of **Sh. 281,720.40** in respect of registration fees and late registration fees where agreements had exceeded the statutory period of 30 days after execution, was collected during the year as shown in the table annexed as Appendix XXXVI.

ESTATE DUTY SECTION

As in the previous years this section has had to deal with assessments under two classes; those for estates arising before the suspension of the application of the former Estate Duty Ordinance in 1959 and which have not been finalized, and those for estates which have arisen since 12th June, 1963 when the Estate Duty Act was reintroduced. The dates given in Appendix XXXVI have been so arranged as to indicate under which of the two statutes assessments have been raised.

During the year 906 assessments were raised under the Act and the duty assessed amounted to £519,410. Fourteen assessments were raised under the Ordinance but did not attract duty.

Of the total number of estates passing and assessed under the Act, no liability arose in 424 estates, i.e. 46 per cent, as the net value in each case did not exceed £5,000, £1,000 or £2,500 according to whether the deceased died prior to or after 15th June, 1967, or whether the deceased died after 16th June, 1972 respectively. Of the remaining 482 estates (comprising 54 per cent) 445 estates attracted duty varying from one to 35 per cent, and 37 estates attracted duty at the fixed rates provided for under Finance Act No. 20 of 1967.

Corrective Accounts were received in 174 estates. Of these, in 151 additional assets were brought to account, while in 23 estates a refund was claimed.

Of the Corrective Accounts mentioned above, 173 were subject to the provisions of the Act and one to the provisions of the Ordinance. Of those filed under the Act no payment of duty was involved in three accounts. The remaining accounts attracted additional duty to the value of £75,136 and £3,755 respectively.

All the 16 estates in which a refund was claimed were subject to the provisions of the Act and duty amounting to £9,440 was refunded in all 16 estates.

In seven remaining Corrective Accounts reduced duty amounting to £3,004 was assessed, while in one estate duty was reduced by remission of £27,043.

The net amount of duty collected during this year amounted to £555,638.

TRADE UNION SECTION

There were 55 unions on the register at the end of the year. The number can be broken down as follows: Employees' 40 with mixed membership. Employers': 15 unions with mixed membership.

During the year one trade union was registered, namely, the Kenya Bakers and Confectioners Workers' Union, whilst the number of branches registered was five.

The dissolution of one trade union, namely, the East African Cabin Crew Union was registered during the year. Also registered was the dissolution of two trade union branches. Further the registration of one trade union, namely, the Kenya Union of National Parks Employees was cancelled on the grounds that the trade union had wilfully and after notice from the Registrar failed to submit its annual returns for the year ended 31st December, 1975 on or before 1st April, 1976.

Application for registration from one trade union was refused—the Kenya National Seamen's Union, on the grounds that there was another trade union already registered which sufficiently represented the whole or a substantial proportion of the interests in respect of which the applicants sought registration. Applications for registration from the following three trade unions received during the year were still pending at the end of the year : National Union of Tenants Rights (Kenya), Private, Vocational and Allied Teachers Union (Kenya), and Associated Society of Kenya White Collar Workers.

Amendments to rules of seven **trade** unions were registered.

Approval was given to 10 union officials to act in full time capacity during the year.

Two employees' trade unions registered changes of names; the East African Pilots Association and National East African Seamen's Union became the Kenya Airline Pilots Association and National Seamen's Union of Kenya respectively.

The secretaries of three trade unions were prosecuted for failing to submit their unions' annual returns for 1976. Six treasurers and branch treasurers were also prosecuted for failing to produce books of account to the Registrar for examination and four of these prosecutions resulted in convictions with fines being imposed.

Two notices of dissolution of a branch of a trade union submitted for registration were referred to the Trades Unions Tribunal on the grounds that the Registrar was not satisfied as to the propriety of the purported dissolutions and appropriate directions were given to the Registrar.

During the year officers of the trade unions section carried out inspections of 191 sets of trade union books of account, being the accounts of 39 head offices and 152 branches. In addition to inspections carried out in Nairobi and its environs, inspections were also carried out in Nakuru, Kisii, Homa Bay, Kisumu and Machakos.

Details of book and voting membership of the trade unions on the register with particulars of their income and expenditure as shown by their annual returns, are set out in Appendices and hereto. The totals of the book and voting members of Appendices XXXVIII and XXXVIII hereto. The totals of the book and voting members of unions had a total of 3,350 book members and 3,350 voting members.

SOCIETIES BOOKS AND NEWSPAPERS

There were 5,135 societies registered and 1,069 exempted from registration as at 31st December, 1977. During the year, 519 societies were registered and nine societies were exempted from registration, three of which had been previously registered. This compared with 586 registrations and 20 exemptions effected in the previous year.

The breakdown of the registered societies as at 31st December, 1977 is 2,416 welfare, 95 professional, 391 sports clubs, 524 political (KANU, its branches and sub-branches), 454 tribal and clan welfare, 575 religious, 169 proprietary (night clubs), and 511 social clubs (members clubs). Of these 60 welfare, 7 professional, 56 sports clubs, 38 religious, 148 proprietary, 210 social clubs were registered in 1977. A total of 114 societies were refused registration and the registrations of 89 societies were cancelled mainly for failing to comply with orders served under the Act and for failing to submit annual returns. 25 societies successfully appealed against cancellation of their registrations. Five other societies exempted from registration had their exemptions rescinded as they had ceased to exist.

BOOKS AND NEWSPAPERS

The number of newspapers registered as at 31st December, 1977 was 83, an increase of 4 over the previous year. During the year 5 new registrations were effected and 1 newspaper filed notice of cessation of publication.

There were 5,696 books registered as at 31st December, 1977. This represented an increase of 141 over 1976 of which 45 per cent were educational, 40 per cent religious and 15 per cent ranged from commercial to fiction. 147 books were printed in English, 80 in Swahili, 7 in French, 2 in German. 20 in 4 vernacular languages, i.e. Luo, Kikuyu, Luhya and Kisii.

THE COLLEGE OF ARMS

There were 8 new applications for grants of arms during the year. However, the college had the opportunity to consider only 4 of them, of which 3 were approved. 2 of these were for local government authorities, and the third for a professional board.

ACCOUNTS SECTION

Fees collected by the Department in respect of various services rendered to the public totalled £187,443 for the year ended 31st December, 1977 as compared with £174,661 the previous year. A total of £550,329 was collected in respect of Estate Duty as compared with £487,782 for the previous year, resulting in an increase of £62,547. The total expenditure of the Department on personal emoluments and other charges amounted to £269,633.
